REPORT OF PRINCIPAL AND SCHOOL IMPROVEMENT COUNCIL

Edisto Beach Elementary continues to strive for academic excellence. The school's report card rating and Palmetto Gold Award indicate a strong instructional program.

During 2009-2010, the teaching assignments remained departmentalized in grades 2-6. Our staff believes this enhances effective classroom instruction, because the teachers develop multi-grade lessons to address standards for all students.

The contributions of a strong and dedicated PTO encourage excellence among our students and staff. The PTO continues to financially support and assist in addressing the academic and enrichment needs of the school. PTO upgraded the playground during the 2009 summer and continues to provide field trips and student incentive awards.

Our community strongly supports our school. Community members volunteer regularly at EBE. A grant from Edisto Art Guild funded a Poetry Alive performance in February. A Guild volunteer gave after-school art lessons for an "Art in March" program. The King's Daughters donated money for our science program.
