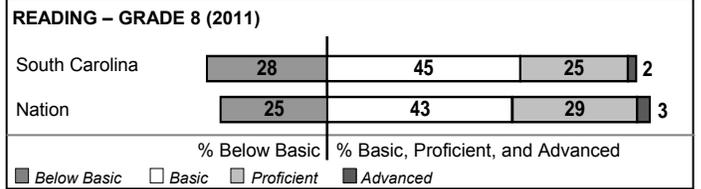
PASS PERFORMANCE
