Definitions of Performance Rating Terms

* Technical Skill Attainment --- The percentage of students enrolled in career and technology courses at the center who earn a 2.0 or above on the final course grade.

* Graduation Rate --- The percentage of 12th grade career and technology students who graduate in the spring.

* Placement Rate --- The percentage of career and technology completers available for placement over a 3-year period who are actually placed in postsecondary instruction, military services, or employment.

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Report of Director and School Improvement Council

Anderson Five Career Campus is a public high school that is located in the downtown historic district of Anderson, SC. We currently serve roughly 2,200 students in grades 9th-12th that travel from the two high schools in Anderson District Five. We have 31 teachers that are certified in their teaching field. Within our staff we have 6 National Board certified teachers, 3 Master PLTW teachers, and 1 Master Automotive certified teacher. Our curriculum is designed to provide our students with real life, project based, hands on experiences that will help them to become career and college ready. We are unique in a sense that our students are able to choose a career path and work through various levels of their choice. Our students are able to obtain college credit and a completer's certificate upon completion of a major.

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ESEA/Federal Accountability Rating System

In July 2013, the South Carolina Department of Education was granted a waiver from several accountability requirements of the Federal High and Secondary Education Act (ESEA). This waiver allowed SC to replace the former pass/fail system with one that utilizes more of the statewide assessments already in place and combine these subject area results with graduation rate (in high schools) to determine if each school met the target or made progress toward the target. This analysis results in a letter grade for the school rather than the pass/fail system of previous years.
