


SC PASS PERFORMANCE

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REPORT OF PRINCIPAL AND SCHOOL IMPROVEMENT COUNCIL

The 2013-2014 school year was an exciting and successful year at Monaview Elementary School. Title1 Planning/SIC Committee, PTA, Faculty Council, staff, and students worked together to establish a shared vision. As a learning community, Monaview used the Greenville County School's Educational Plan as a framework to establish and implement directional goals which led to increased student performances in the core subject areas of English Language Arts, and mathematics as measured by MAP. After reviewing current test data, virtual science lab surveys, SC State Standards, Common Core Standards, student benchmark data and priority goals were established to increase student performances in science, mathematics and reading. Strategies to support these goals included continued professional development in Math, Differentiated Instruction, Balance Literacy Training, and vocabulary development for all teachers. With the assistance of teachers, students established individual academic goals for the school year. Academic rigor in instruction was enhanced through grade level reading and mathematics intervention groups.
