


SC PASS PERFORMANCE

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REPORT OF PRINCIPAL AND SCHOOL IMPROVEMENT COUNCIL

GREEN Charter School is a comprehensive K5 through 7th grade school that serves students in the Greenville, SC and surrounding areas. In 2013-2014, approximately 277 students attended GREEN Charter School. Our class size averaged less than twenty students per class. Our school is an active learning community that provides broad academic and extracurricular programs. Approximately 90% of our students attended our after school clubs and tutoring programs.

Data Driven School: MAP (K5-6th) and Benchmark (3rd-6th) Tests are utilized to monitor student progress. GREEN teachers help their students through after school, Saturday, and pull out tutoring to close the gap in math and reading scores.

Energy Conservation: Our unique school building utilizes the most cost effective resources available to us to reduce energy usage, recover costs and make environmental awareness a priority. Twenty-nine skylights, the installation of high efficiency HVAC system and energy conscious lighting solutions are examples of a few of the ways we work to significantly reduce energy costs. We recently applied for an energy grant that will enable us to build solar panels and a wind turbine on the roof of our school.

Green Step School: As part of our vision statement, we are committed in developing an understanding of environmental sustainability, renewable energy, and technology to enhance students' achievements. The Green Steps Schools program is an environmental education and action initiative that recognizes schools in South Carolina who take annual sustainable steps toward becoming more environmentally responsible. For the school year 2013-2014, GREEN Charter's goal was to have at least one project for each category of the Green Steps Program.

GREEN Charter is very grateful for the opportunity to serve the educational needs of our community. We greatly appreciate the support we have received from our families and surrounding neighbors. Our success is directly tied to the partnerships that have been formed. We are very excited about all that is to come. As we continue to strive for excellence, we look forward to the ongoing development and growth of GREEN Charter School here in Greenville, SC.
