




#### READING - GRADE 8 (2013)

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**REPORT OF PRINCIPAL AND SCHOOL IMPROVEMENT COUNCIL**

Brashier Middle College Charter High School provides a challenging curriculum for students to prepare them for both college and careers. During the past school year, the faculty focused on presenting various strategies and assignments to develop thinking and problem solving strategies to our students. This emphasis is critical in preparing each student to succeed in an environment of changing educational standards, college expectations, and workplace skills.

Our graduating class of 94 students earned nearly 2000 college hours with a 99% pass rate. They earned over \$3,250,000 in college scholarships. These accomplishments are just one indicator of the amazing work our students produce during their four years at Brashier.

Students were also committed to serving the community. They collectively performed over 21,000 hours of community service. They also raised over \$15,000 for various causes including breast cancer research, leukemia research, and Safe Harbor.

As a small school, the focus of our efforts remains on the success of the students. Building a community of parents, students, staff, and board members, we strive to collectively build upon our strengths.
