**RE:** Title I Support Schools

Title I Support Schools are Title I served schools receiving a “D” or “F” grade that are not identified as “Priority” or “Focus” Schools. Due to funding limitations, only newly identified Title I Support Schools (based on the 2014 assessment results) that did not previously receive Title I Support funding are eligible to receive an allocation. “F” schools will receive \$48,000 and “D” schools will receive \$42,000.

The purpose of this funding and the focus of requested activities should be to address the areas of the Elementary and Secondary Education Act (ESEA) Matrix where Annual Measurable Objectives (AMO’s) were not met. Examples of allowable activities include: part-time interventionist, tutoring, after school program, professional development for teachers, supplies and materials, etc. Technology purchases are allowable as well, but will be heavily scrutinized in comparison to the Title I plan. The examples provided are not an exhaustive list of allowable activities. Please contact your South Carolina Department of Education Project Manager for questions and guidance.

Please input requested activities in the 2015 Title I online application in the appropriate School wide Plan by choosing the “New TI Support 1003(a) Activity” selection. After completion of all school activities, please have the district superintendent submit through the online application by May 16, 2015. For your convenience, a “TI Summary Budget Report” has been added in the district menu of the online application to summarize all school level activities associated with this funding for the district. Use this Budget Report to aid in loading the district budget into GAPS.

These funds are available through June 30, 2016.
