


2014 SCHOOL HEALTH PROFILES REPORT

Principal Charts Documentation

Purpose The Principal Charts graphically describe results from every variable on the principal questionnaire for the overall sample. These bar charts are in a PowerPoint file and are useful for creating presentations or adding to your own Profiles report.

Example



Content The title of each chart indicates that the results come from the principal survey and that the data are weighted. The question number and a summary of the question appear under the title. The response options for the question or subparts of the question are listed down the left margin of the chart. In some charts, question numbers are followed by the letter N (e.g., 21N). The data contained in these charts were derived from combining two or more response options to a single question or two or more questions or question subparts.

Where this occurs, the response options, questions, or question subparts used in creating the combined variable are listed in a footnote.

Each item in the chart contains four bars: one for each of three categories of schools (high schools, middle schools, and junior/senior high schools) and one for all schools combined (all schools). Each bar represents the percentage of schools in each category and overall that responded to the question as described in the question summary at the top of each chart. For each bar, the percent is to the right of the bar.

Notes

Principal Charts are provided only for weighted principal results.

Each bar chart corresponds to a Principal Table. Refer to the corresponding table to see more detailed results for each variable.
