



REPORT OF SUPERINTENDENT

Working together as a school district and community, Spartanburg School District 4 provides a successful academic environment. We lead the state in the percent of students enrolled in AP courses and score above the state average on PACT. Our fine arts program has continually produced SC top ten visual arts students along with a competitive, talented and well-disciplined band. Our athletic program has expanded to include soccer, cross-country, competitive cheerleading, as well as JV programs in softball, volleyball, and wrestling. Woodruff High School is a past winner of the Blue Ribbon High School award determined by the US Department of Education and was recently named one of the Top High Schools in America by Newsweek magazine.

Our comprehensive early childhood initiative incorporates parenting classes, childcare-supported adult education, and programs for students as young as three years old. Spartanburg Four offers full-day kindergarten for all four year-old students. Woodruff Primary School recently earned the Exemplary Writing Award by the SC Department of Education. Primary and elementary-aged students are engaged in a rich academic curriculum that includes a strong focus on reading and mathematics, as well as exciting hands-on science instruction. Students at the high-school level pursue studies in rigorous courses that complete their preparation for higher education, employment, and community service. The last year of a comprehensive five-year strategic plan has resulted in numerous improvements for students. A major curricular emphasis on individualization of instruction for all students, utilizing computer technology to assess student progress has shown preliminary success.

We will continue to make academic opportunities for students a high priority while insuring the safety of our children and employees, and will continue to communicate with parents, students, and the community in an effort to provide a climate of personalization and sense of family atmosphere in our schools.
