

The Mt. Pleasant Academy faculty and staff and the School Improvement Council are proud to share our 2009 successes with you. We had another productive year in our temporary location at Wando South. We are nearing completion on the construction of our new facility. We are all very excited that we will start the 2009-2010 school year in our new state-of-the-art facility on Center Street.

Mt. Pleasant Academy continues to excel as a National No Child Left Behind Blue Ribbon School. Academic achievement for all groups of students showed improvement during the last school year. We continue to have the highest absolute student achievement rating of all non-magnet schools in South Carolina.

Our school once again was named a Palmetto Gold Award Winner by the South Carolina State Department of Education. We have met our goal of 75% of our third, fourth, and fifth graders scoring Proficient or Advanced on all PACT subtests.
