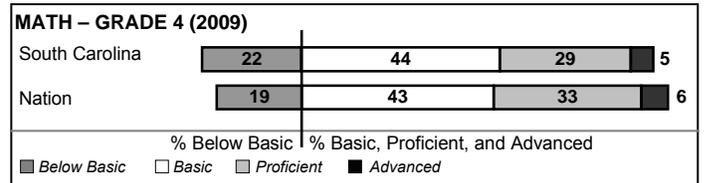
## PASS PERFORMANCE

## REPORT OF PRINCIPAL AND SCHOOL IMPROVEMENT COUNCIL

Woodfields begin the 2009-2010 school year by providing staff development and grade level meetings on Professional Learning Communities, "Highly Effective Teaching, Lifelong Guidelines" and Response to Intervention. These workshops were given to encourage communication, teamwork and ownership of all students by all staff.

Parental Involvement was encouraged by having monthly parent reading workshops to support parents in reading to and with their child.

The School Improvement Council and PTO provided support, incentives, and participated in developing and implementing the school's strategic plan. Our "Community in the School Night" provided the community the opportunity to meet parents and get involved with Woodfields Elementary School.

Woodfields met their annual yearly progress (AYP) by meeting 25 out of 25 objectives for student indicators on PASS.

We continued our Intergrated Arts Program (ACTS) and expanded our Single-Gender Program and to become part of the district choice programs.
