


PASS PERFORMANCE

REPORT OF PRINCIPAL AND SCHOOL IMPROVEMENT COUNCIL

Pine Ridge Middle School's staff collaborated to create a mission based on shared beliefs titled Student Freedoms, Manners and Expectations. The new mission of PRMS is to use data to provide diverse opportunities for all students to learn the skills that enable them to be successful, healthy, lifelong, global learners. Teachers used PASS and MAP scores to differentiate instruction. Classroom guidance lessons covered a variety of subjects through Character Education. All students used Classworks software to work on building reading and math skills. This year, teachers participated in district cohorts to research, analyze data, and publish a product from their group. The cohorts were developed from teacher surveys and facilitated by teachers.

Teachers continue to gain recognition through awards, workshops, and grants. Our teachers received recognition from the National Board Review Team and SC Streamline. They attended workshops for National Math Conference and Roper Mountain Science. They also received grant money from Champions of the Environment and SC Art in Schools. Our AYP rating improved from 13 to 19 of 21 objectives. Although we did not meet AYP, we improved in 6 categories. PRMS students donated \$104.84 to Pets, Inc., our local animal shelter. Our athletic teams continued to be successful both at the district and conference level. PRMS students were featured in a Champions of the Environment commercial on WIS-TV. Art students won the Lions Club International Peace Poster contest. Two students were 2009 SC State Fair winners. The 6th-grade classes created a 4X8 ply board Christmas card which was on display in the Lights Before Christmas Holiday Card Project at Riverbanks Zoo. Streamline SC in collaboration with ETV recognized PRMS teachers and students with a Lifetime Achievement Award. Two students earned a chair in the SC All-Region 2 Honor Band. One student represented PRMS at the 2010 SC Young Writers' Conference. Seven students qualified and were recognized by the Myrdis Walker Scholarship program. Two students attended Allen University's Saturday Science Academy.

By all students, parents and staff members working together, we feel that Pine Ridge Middle School students will continue to be successful and reach their future goals.
