
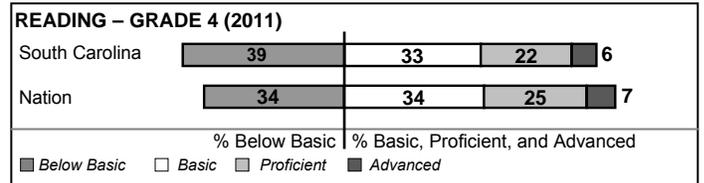
PASS PERFORMANCE
