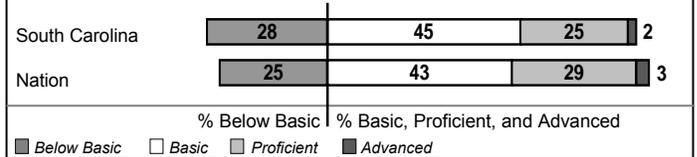

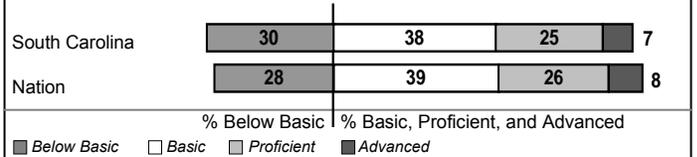

REPORT OF PRINCIPAL AND SCHOOL IMPROVEMENT COUNCIL

Abbeville High School has thirty five certified faculty members working with our students. Among these teachers twenty two have advanced degrees and seventeen are National Board Certified. This dedication to life long learning by our teachers is a benefit to our students and demonstrates a commitment to academic excellence.

The 2011 graduating class of one hundred and twenty eight continues our tradition of excellence by receiving over two million seven hundred thousand dollars in scholarship money. Forty percent of the graduating class will attend a four year institution, forty five percent will attend a two year community college, seven percent will enlist in the military, four percent will use Vocational Rehabilitations services and five percent will be joining the full-time workforce.

We believe all students have the right to learn in a safe, comfortable and disciplined environment. We commit ourselves to student success and believe every student should have an opportunity to fulfill his or her potential. We are proud of our school, our community and we look forward to the future.
