


PASS PERFORMANCE

The accomplishment of the Magna Cum Laude Award for high improvement in our ACT scores was the highlight of this school year. We are still a National Blue Ribbon School and Red Carpet School. Our graduation rate was 79.6%. The percentage of students' first attempts at passing both HSAP math and ELA was 95.1%, earning a report card rating of Average.

Major academic programs and initiatives that contributed to our progress include: Department Parent Nights, ACT and SAT Preparation, PLATO, Skills Tutor, USA Test Prep, Virtual School, Voyager, Data-driven curriculum, instruction, and assessment, and 21st Century Afterschool Program for middle school students.
