

- Student Achievement
 - 33 Fifth Graders have been k/1 Mentors

 - Students raised \$2,550 for Jump for Heart
 - Students walked the equivalent of 249.5 miles for Walk AT School Day
 - RCES Students along with some adult encouragement developed the Red Cedar Gazette – a student produced newsletter
- Participation in Club Activities
 - Red Cedar has 8 clubs including: Art Club, Compass Learning Club, Dance Ensembles, Drum & Dance, Foxes Trot, Foxes Score Sports, Honors Choir, Theater, Robotics
