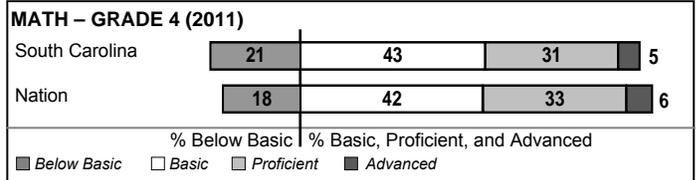

PASS PERFORMANCE
