REPORT OF PRINCIPAL AND SCHOOL IMPROVEMENT COUNCIL

Westminster Elementary has had a very successful year! The percentage of students who scored 'Met' and/or 'Exemplary' on PASS increased in Writing, Math, and English-Language Arts from the 2010-11 School Year to the 2011-2012 School year. Our highest percentage of growth on PASS occurred in Math, with a growth of 9.4 percentage points of students who received 'Met' and/or 'Exemplary'. We also monitor student performance with the Measurements of Academic Performance (MAP) assessment. Once again, our school increased our average scores by over 11 points in all areas of MAP which includes Language, Reading, and Math from Fall 2011 to Spring 2012. The mean score for Math jumped from an average RIT of 189.09 in the Fall of 2011 to 203.59 in the Spring of 2012. This is a 14 point gain!

Our school has three interventionist that serve kindergarten through fifth grades in the areas of Math and English-Language Arts. We also have a part time interventionist that intervenes with kindergarteners using the Early Reading Intervention (ERI) Program. We have one resource teacher that provides support to students with Individualized Education Plans in the general education setting as well as two self-contained special education classes.

Our teachers strive for excellence academically and behaviorally. Our school just recently received "Banner" status by the State of South Carolina Department of Education for our school's fidelity and quality in implementing school-wide Positive Behavior Interventions and Supports (PBIS). Our school implemented the Chick-Fil-A Core Essential Character Education Program school-wide in which students were recognized monthly by their peers for displaying character traits. They also got to eat breakfast with the principal and were presented an award from a student athlete from Clemson's University's Be a T.I.G.E.R Program.

Our school has programs in place to ensure that our children are learning about healthy life styles. This year we received the Safe Kids Safe Schools Award by Safe Kids Upstate and Oconee Medical Center. This award is for schools that demonstrate excellence in efforts of teaching students healthy lifestyles. For example, we have a safety patrol team at our school, we participated in the National Walk-to-School Day, we have a daily Morning Movers Club, and we recently started plans to build an outdoor track.

Westminster Elementary students have opportunities to participate in an array of extra curriculum clubs and activities. We have a student council for grades 3-5 as well as a Cardinal Honors Club for grade 5. Both of these clubs participated in community service projects this year. We raised money for a local soup kitchen as well as to support a school in Haiti. Student Council also raised funds for Amazima vocational program which helps employ women in Uganda. Other extracurricular activities include chorus, Act Out Drama Club, Battle of the Books Club, Math Madness Team, and Tiger Relay Team. We strive for excellence and always make sure that "children come first!"
