



READING – GRADE 4 (2011)




READING – GRADE 8 (2011)



MATH – GRADE 4 (2011)




MATH – GRADE 8 (2011)



REPORT OF PRINCIPAL AND SCHOOL IMPROVEMENT COUNCIL

East Pointe Academy (EPA) is a public charter school that opened in August 2011 serving grades Pre-K through grade 2. EPA is South Carolina's only school-wide, Chinese language immersion school. Students learn to speak, write and understand Chinese through language immersion classes in math, science and Mandarin Language Arts. In addition, students learn Mandarin and Chinese culture during related arts classes. Differentiation and a personal school experience serve as the basis for the instructional program which incorporates elements of Montessori, character development, community service, inquiry learning and ecology. The PTO and School Improvement Council are active sponsoring many school activities. The school has a daily afterschool program which includes homework assistance as well as martial arts, violin, beginner dance and Lego League. The Board of Trustees is elected by the parents of our students. The re-enrollment rate is 98.3% with an enrollment growth rate of 85% for the 2012-2013 school year. We are preparing bright children for brighter futures.
