Shaw Heights Elementary is a public Title I school located on Shaw Air Force Base. Our school serves both military and non-military families. We strive to create a warm, nurturing environment for our students to excel and achieve in all areas. Many parent involvement opportunities are implemented throughout the school year. Teachers work collaboratively with the parents to ensure that all children have a positive learning experience. Our School Improvement Council has made a commitment to provide support for the school's mission and performance goals, and to encourage the involvement of the community.

Shaw Heights Elementary experienced success with our students earning an "Excellent" rating on our Annual School Report Card for the past three years. Our test scores on the PASS earned our school the honor of the Palmetto Gold Award. Teachers, students, faculty, parents, and community members shared in the celebrations of our success. Some of the steps taken to ensure our students are achieving at a high level include correlating our curriculum with the state standards, participating in on-going professional development, intervention in reading and math, inclusion challenge classes, educational software programs, and a variety of parent involvement activities.
