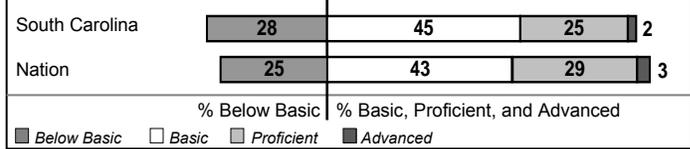

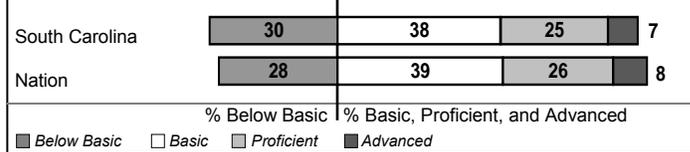

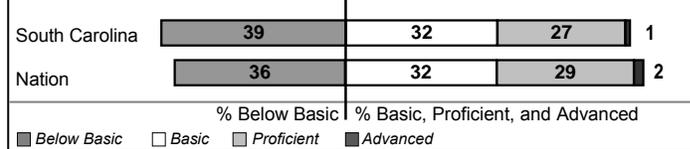
READING – GRADE 8 (2011)

REPORT OF PRINCIPAL AND SCHOOL IMPROVEMENT COUNCIL

Cane Bay Middle School opened its doors and welcomed students in grades 6-8 for the 2012-2013 school year. It was an exciting new beginning for the students, staff, and parents. Our school is located off Highway 176 within the newly developed Cane Bay Plantation. Our population primarily consists of students who previously attended two other middle schools within Berkeley County. Our school employs 28 certified professionals, 4 instructional paraprofessionals, and 16 support staff members. Of the 28 certified staff members, 14 have advanced degrees, and 3 are National Board Certified Teachers. Cane Bay provides an exceptional learning environment and is accredited through the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools.

Students come to Cane Bay Middle School to experience academic excellence within a safe and caring learning environment. Teachers collaborate with their colleagues to identify the essential learning for each grade and content area, plan collaboratively to engage the learners, and provide specific, targeted instruction to insure student learning and success exist. The Cane Bay Middle staff work tirelessly to improve their professional knowledge. In addition to district required early-release days and district/school staff-development days, professional development is provided for instructional staff members through an embedded schedule.

Cane Bay Middle School has flourished in its inaugural year due to the determination, enthusiasm, and resilience of our students, as well as the generosity and continued support of our community members and stakeholders. Our students excelled in the classroom and in extracurricular competitions. Student accomplishments include: 2 Duke TIP Scholars; 9 Junior Scholars; 2 qualifiers to the Low-Country Spelling Bee; 1 3rd Place Finish in the Low-Country Spelling Bee; in the QUEST Competition we were 3rd Place Overall Level I; 1st Place Level I Math; 3rd Place Level I Science; and 3rd Place Level I Social Studies; 1st and 3rd Place in Dimension U Contest (Hosted by SPAWAR); 2 students selected for All-County Orchestra; 3 students selected for All-County Band; and 2 students selected for All-Region Band. Our students have also exemplified the "Cane Bay Way" by becoming involved in community service organizations such Relay for Life, and Make a Wish Foundation. In addition, the Cane Bay Middle Student Council participated in the Cane Bay Community Fair to help provide food and clothing to Cane Bay families during the holiday season.

Cane Bay Middle is a member of "Making Middle Grades Work"—a model for continuous school improvement based on best practices research. The faculty and staff have spent many hours participating in Professional Learning Communities to build a foundation for collaboration and teamwork. Our area of focus will continue to be the full implementation of Common Core State Standards as we prepare for the rigorous challenges of the Smarter Balanced assessment.

As we move forward and grow as a school, we will continue to build the character, leadership skills and traditions that are an embodiment of the Cane Bay Spirit and the Cane Bay Way!
