

PASS PERFORMANCE

Our student athletes excelled not only in the sports arenas, vying for the Upper State Championship in Football and winning the first Region title in basketball in 25years, but also achieving the highest SAT average score in our WPEC consortium. Our Junior High received a Silver Award for the second year in a row and also scored 93.9 % on the 2012 - ESEA / Federal Accountability System. Our student body continues to serve our community with our annual "Christmas for Kids" fund drive as well as the re-birth of "Farm Day" which highlighted our agricultural department. Our students hosted a District Student Council Rally with two of our students holding state level offices. At this writing, we are in preparation for an AdvancEd visit in April. All stakeholders, faculty and staff have undergone a rigorous self- assessment and eagerly await validation of our efforts.
