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REPORT OF PRINCIPAL AND SCHOOL IMPROVEMENT COUNCIL

Paul Knox Middle School is home to approximately 675 students in grades 6-8 in North Augusta, SC. Our school is traditionally noted as one of the premiere schools in Aiken County and this year was no exception. Our students once performed at high levels in both academic and extra-curricular affairs throughout the year. Academically, our students performed well on End of Course testing and our PASS testing results indicated strong results in several areas but improvement is needed in others. Continuous improvement is always the expectation at Paul Knox Middle School and proper adjustments will be made to see growth in all academic areas.

Paul Knox's mission statement stresses the education of each student and the preparation for high school. Our vision is to provide an outstanding environment where students can become successful members of our global society. This vision requires Paul Knox Middle School to constantly strive to provide our students with additional support. This year, we created enrichment classes to provide additional academic support in our core curriculum classes. We also hired math and ELA tutors to provide support for our students who needed the additional assistance.

With assistance from Public Education Partners and an array of local business and individual supporters, Paul Knox Middle School opened the synergistic lab this year. The synergistic lab is a wonderful facility designed to integrate science knowledge with hands-on activities. The lab is a great addition as we continue to focus on science, technology, engineering and math at Paul Knox Middle School.

In other areas of success:

25 students were recognized as South Carolina Junior Scholars. 36 students qualified for the DUKE TIP program. 24 students were selected for the Aiken county band. 8 students were selected for the All-Region band. 25 students were selected for the Aiken county choir. 100% of our 8th graders passed the Algebra 1 End of Course exams. 100% of our 8th graders passed the English 1 End of Course exams. 116 new students were inducted into our BETA Club. Our academic team was undefeated and won the Aiken County championship. Our Future City team placed 1st in Aiken County and 2nd in regional competition. Our volleyball team completed an undefeated regular season with a record of 12-0. Our football team completed the season with a 4-3 record. Our boys' basketball team won the division championship and completed the season with a 12-3 record. Our girls' basketball team completed the season with a 9-4 record. Our golf team completed the season with a 6-1 record and a division championship.

As we conclude another successful year, our vision for continued excellence remains.
