


SC PASS PERFORMANCE

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REPORT OF PRINCIPAL AND SCHOOL IMPROVEMENT COUNCIL

Kingstree Middle School's goal is to provide the highest quality instruction in academic standards. Teachers used the Measures of Academic Progress (MAP) tests and quarterly benchmark testing to monitor students' growth in all core areas. Students who have areas of weaknesses received interventions in reading and math through small group instruction.

Kingstree Middle School provided a number of instructional programs for students who were not meeting their academic goals. These programs included the 21st Century After-school program, Saturday School and Classworks curriculum lab. All lessons and activities were aligned with the State standards, as we move toward the Common Core standards. In addition, two full-time guidance counselors continued to provide academic, social and personal assistance for our students.

Other programs and activities that were provided to help build our students' character and prepare them to survive in a constantly changing and diverse world included: The Parenting Program, Teen Life, RBHS and our Foster Grandparents Program, through the local Vital Aging Commission, which allows our older generation to pass knowledge and character to our younger generation.

Our students received numerous academic awards this past school year. A few of these recognitions include students representing our school at the Pee Dee Region Spelling Bee Contest, Mock Trial Competition, and the Pee Dee Academic Challenge Championship. We are also very proud to have two Junior Scholars.

Kingstree Middle would like to thank all our parents and community members for their effortless support that they have shown us this school year.
