



CHILD EARLY READING DEVELOPMENT AND EDUCATION PROGRAM (CERDEP): POWERSCHOOL PROCESS CHANGE

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Activity codes 17520000, 1751SS00, 1751ES00, 17530000, or 17540000 are no longer used to designate “extended” CERDEP services. Districts will use one of two PowerSchool Special Programs enrollments (Regular or Extended Day) to meet data reporting requirements for this purpose. This document outlines these codes.

REMINDERS

Funded CERDEP students must:

- Be enrolled in an appropriate course section,
- have a valid special program code (see below),
- be age four on or before Sept. 1 of the current school year, and
- have a state student number (SUNS ID).

Districts with summer programs or extended school years for CERDEP students should follow the steps outlined in the document [SC School & Program Setup Guide for PowerSchool](#) in addition to student-level coding procedures outlined in this document. SPECIAL PROGRAMS: CERDEP CODES

The following Special Program codes must be used by districts with CERDEP programs approved through the Office of Early Learning and Literacy.
