

In response to Act 281 and H.5140, the Education Oversight Committee (EOC) selected the following criteria for identification of “potentially underperforming schools and districts”:

A District will be identified as underperforming if it meets two or more of the following criteria:

- A district 4-year graduation rate of less than 70%;
- A district where the mean of percentage of students in Grades 3-8 scoring “Does Not Meet Expectations” on SCReady ELA or SCReady Mathematics is greater than 50%;
- A district with less than 20% of eligible students scoring a Silver or better on WorkKeys;
- A district with less than 5% of students scoring 22 or higher on ACT in Reading or Mathematics;

A High School will be identified as underperforming if the composite average in the following four criteria together ranks in the bottom 5%:

- Graduation Rate;
- Percentage of juniors earning Silver or higher;
- Percentage of 11GR identified students achieving 22 on ACT Reading or Mathematics;
- Percentage of students scoring C or higher on English 1 and Algebra 1

Middle Schools and Elementary Schools will be clustered as one category will be identified as underperforming if the composite average of students scoring “Does Not Meet” on SC Ready of ELA and Math ranks in the bottom 5%.
