Indicator 8 – Family Engagement

- ▶ Percent of parents with a child receiving special education services who report that schools facilitated parent involvement as a means of improving services and results for children with disabilities.
- ▶ Historically the Office of Special Education Services (OSES) has used a sampling plan to survey parents and measure this indicator.
- ▶ Moving forward the OSES is proposing surveying all parents after the initial evaluation and annual review IEP meetings.
