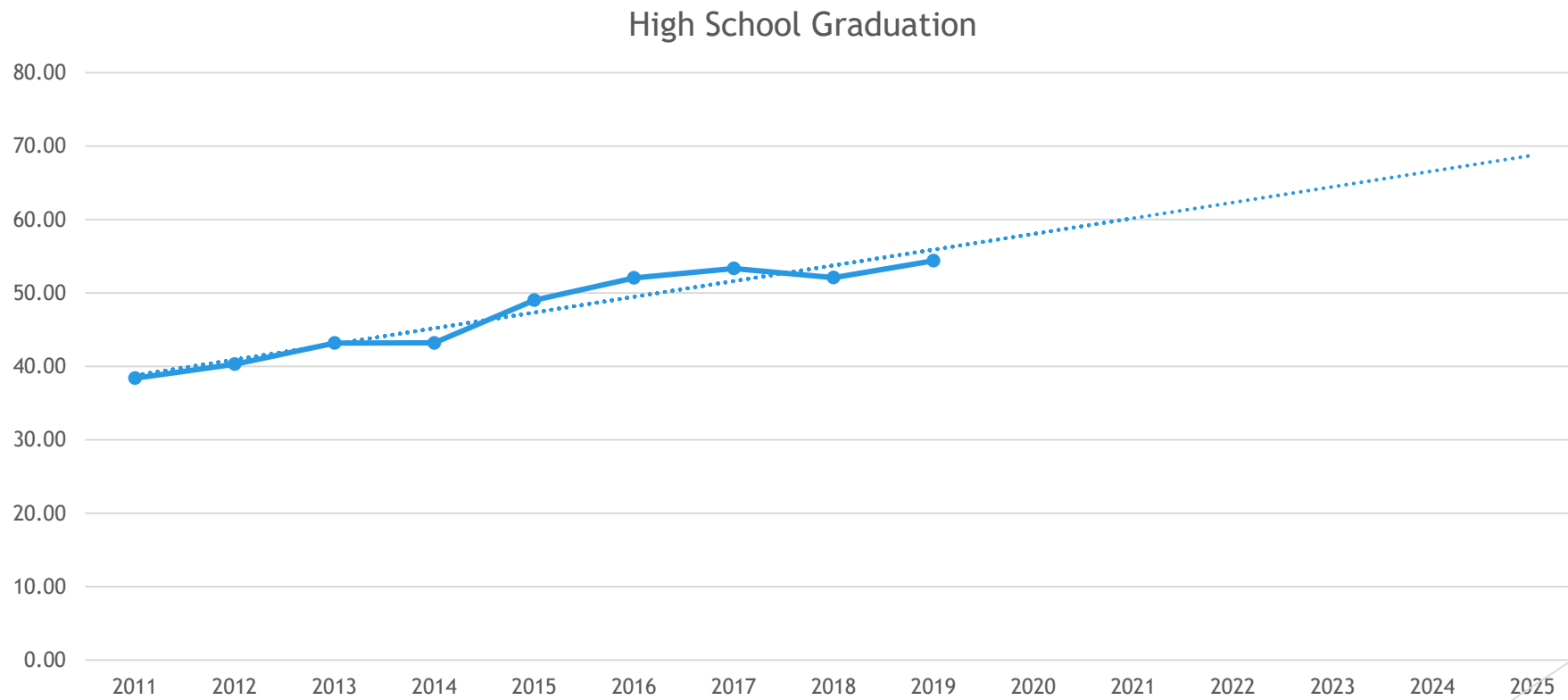
## Indicator 1 - Graduation Rate

- ▶ Percent of youth with IEPs graduating from high school with a regular diploma.

# Projected SPP Targets for Graduation Rate:

Year	2020	2021	2022	2023	2024	2025
Target	57.40%	60.39%	63.38%	66.38%	69.38%	72.37%

New targets were projected using the current trend line of the state average +  $\frac{1}{2}$  a standard deviation to ensure rigorous yet attainable goals.
