Indicator 2 - Dropout Rate for teachers

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- ▶ Percent of youth with IEPs dropping out of high school.

Projected Dropout rate basic on the new Graduation Rates:

Year	2020	2021	2022	2023	2024	2025
Graduation	57.40	60.39	63.38	66.38	69.38	72.37
Dropout	33.60	30.61	27.62	24.62	21.62	18.63

Indicator 2020 Changes

- ▶ Dropout rate goals were set to align with the graduation rate goals. The dropout rate accounts for 9% of students who may not make their 4 year graduation cohort but reenroll to continue working towards their either graduation or a credential.
- ▶ Though the first year target is high - this works off the previous years actual dropout rate and will help buffer the possible effects of the pandemic. The overall six year goal is rigorous.
