Emalee Baker:Do you have any last minute evaluator trainings planned or penciled in? I anticipate those questions to begin..

Patricia Canada:For reading coaches who are not in the regular classroom, how should they be coded in SC Lead in order for the local administrator to put Met or Not Met at the end of the school year.

OEELD-Kim:Daniel, I may need you to clarify. Scores will populate on the Results page based on data input via the Observations feature. The principal/administrator will select the SLO rating on the Results page and the ADEPT administrator will select the recommendations.

Melanie Cohen:Do Districts completed the upload from CPS or is that a manual upload for all districts?

Daniel Oddo:Sorry - I mean, hiring status, contract level, and eval level ... will we upload, or will it be person by person under the results page?

OEELD-Kim:Emalee, our next scheduled evaluator training is January 14-16 at Francis Marion. The registration link is <https://ed.sc.gov/educators/educator-effectiveness/professional-learning/professional-learning-opportunities/>

OEELD-Kim:Patricia, if it is a coaching position that requires ADEPT, they should be coded as Continuing GBE.

OEELD-Kim:Melanie, the upload to SCLead is done through an import spreadsheet found in SCLead. If the district indicated they will be "Import Only" on their ADEPT Plan, this feature would apply to them.

Melanie Cohen:Let me rephrase my question; Do all district need to to the upload from CPS, os does this automatically roll over from CPS?

OEELD-Kim:Educators staffed in the district will roll from PCS to SCLead. When changes are made in PCS, they will be reflected in SCLead.

Emalee Baker:Does SCDE have GBE format examples that are shareable to school leaders for those that do not fall under the SLO category?

Anita Parker 2:Kim, to follow-up on your response to Patricia - I have a copy of the PCS Codes Sheet that was included in the Bi-monthly newsletter dated 8-1-19; however it is dated 2018-19. Is there an updated one (2019-2020) available?

OEELD-Kim:Emalee, section II of the SLO form is geared towards educators on GBE. The district can adjust this form as necessary.

OEELD-Kim:If you're looking for sample GBEs, unfortunately, we do not have any.

Nikki:Thank you all for providing this!!

Melanie Cohen:I am unclear about the import of evaluations. I have downloaded the template, and it does not include all employees.

Emalee Baker:Yes, Kim. Sample GBE is what has been requested. I will share that info. Thanks

Anita Parker 2:Julie - with regards to "observations" in consensus districts, did you say that the "Release Self-Reflection" reminder will NOT appear for the observer?

OEELD-Kim:Melanie, the staff list currently available is based on educators staffed 18-19. When PCS reopens (maybe next week) and staff changes are reflected, those educators will appear on the import spreadsheet.

Patricia Canada:Kim. I just checked and the issue is in the evaluaiton drop down box; it only allows for classroom teacher and if we click on this, a SLO is required.

Anita Parker 2:Thank you Kim! Melanie Cohen:Ok, so we need to wait until PCS reopens to import the changes. And then new employees are added to SCLead, correct?

OEELD-Kim:Leigh, there are no additional changes at this time.

Lilla Toal-Mandsager:Anita, the self-reflection form will not appear on the team consensus page where consensus scores are entered - it will appear on the individual observation scoring page as always

OEELD-Kim:Patricia, that is the only option at this time and in the case of those educators you would have to skip the SLO.

Patricia Canada:Thank you!

OEELD-Kim:Melanie, you can either wait until PCS reopens or add staff using the process we described earlier. If you add staff prior to PCS opening, the records will merge.
