

## **Identification of Critical Need Subject Areas 2022-23**

The South Carolina Department of Education (SCDE) identified the following critical need subject areas for purposes of the South Carolina Teacher Loan Program. The data used for identification purposes were reported by South Carolina school districts through the 2021-22 Annual Supply and Demand Survey administered by the Center for Educator Recruitment, Retention, and Advancement (CERRA). Two districts, Clarendon School District Four and Florence School District Four, did not provide data for the survey.

Determinations were made by using the United States Department of Education (USED) formula for designating teacher shortage areas: the percentage of positions in a given subject area (i.e., certification field) that are unfilled, filled by educators in an alternative route program, or filled by educators holding an out-of-field permit.
