Camp Daniel is an academic program that provides students with instruction in the areas of Math, Reading, Writing, and Computer Skills. Students are assessed academically at the beginning of the program and their academic growth is monitored throughout the program. Students are also provided with field trips and guest speakers in order to learn more about careers and community services. Camp Daniel is a 2-year program with \$75,000.00 spent during June and July of 2024 and \$75,000.00 to be spent during June and July of 2025.
