The CIS evidence-based model offers implementation supports, wraparound services, and behavioral health programming in Title I (public) and/or under-resourced school sites with high levels of student absenteeism, behavioral interventions, and decreased course performance. CISSC implements its model in partnering schools by placing highly trained site coordinators to deliver three tiers of services: 1. Whole school supports, 2. Small group intervention, and 3. one-on-one case management. Our program is designed to support students with increasing attendance, course performance, and on-time annual advancement and graduation, while decreasing behavioral referrals.
