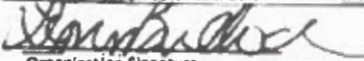

Please explain how these funds will be used to provide a public benefit:

With teenage suicide and violent deaths occurring at alarming rates. This program seeks to identify at risk youth early and intervene to change the trajectory of harm. These funds will be used to conduct an initial modified ACES assessment at several pilot middle schools to identify those students at risk to harm themselves or others. Survey results will be used to place the student into the district counseling program or an in/or after school mentorship program. The results will be used to design a mentorship program aimed at developing resilience. A training program will be conducted to educate teachers and first responders about the program, how to help students in need of support, and how to respond to an active situation. The program will be a collaborative effort between the Jonathan Foundation, the school districts, appropriate governmental agencies, private industry, and community organizations.

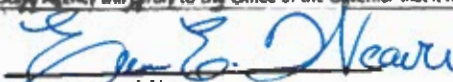
