It is not content specific, and teachers will also be allowed to take the sample test. Additionally, teachers may assign interim items via the <i>Informative Test Tool</i> with content specific items.
15. Are sample test items provided?	Yes.
16. What fields of data are required to be entered to register students for a test?	Teacher Email, Course Code, Student First Name, Student Last Name, Student Grade Level, Student Gender, Race and Ethnicity (if available), Student Date of Birth, Student Grade
17. Who can register students for a test?	Principals, designated school administrators, teachers
18. Who can administer the test?	Principals, designated school administrators, teachers or designated proctors
19. Are teachers allowed to administer/proctor the tests?	Yes
20. What are the rules for proctors?	Adherence to PLTW testing policy as specified in the <a href="#">End-of-Course Administration Manual</a> .
21. Remote/Virtual Proctoring Capabilities	PLTW will offer both in-person and distance administration options. Schools may choose which option to implement.
