Completer Program Description:

Definition: A program that prepares individuals to shampoo, style, and *dress the scalp hair* (?) of women and/or men, braid hair, and prepare for licensure as professional hair braiders. Includes instruction in hair design theory and concepts, hair cleaning and shampooing, hair anatomy and physiology, scalp diseases, hair braiding, customer service, shop management, equipment operation, health and safety, and applicable laws and regulations.

Course Description:

Introduction to Natural Hair Braiding

The Introduction to Natural Hair Braiding Course provides students with an introduction to standards to be successful in a natural hair braiding career. Students will learn the building blocks to more advanced techniques in hair braiding. Content includes an orientation, history, employability skills, hygiene and good grooming, science of hair braiding, bacteriology, sterilization and sanitation, disorders of the skin, scalp, and hair – diseases and treatments, materials and implements, hair care services, hair types, structure, and textural differences. The students practice on manikins, only. This course is an elective for the Natural Hair Braiding completer program.

Natural Hair Braiding 1 and 2

Natural Hair Braiding 1 is a concentrator course and the prerequisite for Natural Hair Braiding 2. This project-based elective course provides students with the knowledge and techniques associated with natural hair structure. African American history, computer science skills (to attract underrepresented populations to computer science), and employability skills are integrated throughout the content to equip students with the skills needed to successfully face challenges of the workplace. A required culminating activity after a minimum of 90 hours with a “C” average is the one-day six-hour course that covers disorders and diseases of the scalp, sanitation and sterilization, policies and procedures, and the SC Board of Barber Examiners statutes, regulations taught by a licensed Barber or Master Hair Care Instructor, leads to the South Carolina Hair Braiding Registration career ready industry-recognized credential.

Natural Hair Braiding 2 students will focus on intricate braiding patterns, experimenting with diverse hair textures, incorporating advanced techniques like feed in braids, knotless braids, and decorative elements, refining their client consultation skills, and exploring specialized braiding styles for specific occasions to further develop their expertise in the field.

Natural Hair Braiding 1 and 2 students have opportunities to compete in local, district, state, and national competitions. Participation in the SkillsUSA Career and Technical Student Organization (CTSO) provides opportunities to refine and develop leadership and technical skills.

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Section 40-7-20. Definitions

(2) "Hair braiding" means the weaving or interweaving of natural human hair for compensation without cutting, coloring, permanent waving, relaxing, removing, or chemical treatment. Hair braiding also includes the use of hair extensions, except when used in public places including, but not limited to, beaches, parks, and sidewalks.

Section 40-7-255. Hair braiding practitioner registration, training, term, and renewal of registration.

(A) Only those individuals who are licensed to practice barbering or cosmetology or who are registered to practice hair braiding (registered hair braider) in this State may engage in the practice of hair braiding or perform hair-braiding services in this State.

"Section 40-7-255. Hair braiding practitioner registration, training, term, and renewal of registration.

- (A) Only those individuals who are licensed to practice barbering or cosmetology or who are registered to practice hair braiding (registered hair braider) in this State may engage in the practice of hair braiding or perform hair-braiding services in this State.
- (B) All implements used in connection with hair braiding must be disposable or must be sanitized in a disinfectant approved for hospital use or approved by the Environmental Protection Agency for hospital use or approved by the Environmental Protection Agency for commercial use.
- (C) To practice hair braiding in this State an individual shall
 - 1) apply to the board for registration in a manner prescribed by the board;
 - 2) provide satisfactory proof of successful completion of a one-day, six-hour;
 - 3) pass an examination administered by the board; and
 - 4) pay a twenty-five-dollar registration fee.
- (D) Hair braiding shall include instruction regarding:
 - (1) sanitation and sterilization including:
 - (a) universal sanitation and sterilization precautions;
 - (b) how to distinguish between disinfectants and antiseptics; and
 - (c) how to sanitize hands and disinfect tools used in the practice of hair braiding;
 - (2) disorders and diseases of the scalp, including:
 - (a) how to distinguish between these disorders and diseases; and
 - (b) when hair braiding services can be performed on a client with disorders or diseases of the scalp.
 - (3) where and when an individual may legally practice hair braiding; and law;
 - (4) the procedures, fees, and requirements for renewal of a hair braiding registration.

- (E) Registration to practice hair braiding is valid for two years or until the end of the biennial licensure renewal cycle in which the registration is first issued, whichever occurs first. The holder of a registration to practice hair braiding shall renew his or her registration by paying the renewal fee.
- (F) An individual currently engaging in the practice of hair braiding on the effective date of this act has one year from the effective date to complete the registration requirements as provided for in this section.
