
2024 HIGH QUALITY INSTRUCTIONAL MATERIALS ADOPTION CALENDAR OF EVENTS

November 1, 2023	Instructional Materials Advisory Committee (IMAC) meeting held to determine recommendations for the 2024 adoption cycle.
December 12	The State Board of Education (SBE) receives for approval the IMAC recommendations for the 2024 adoption cycle.
December–January 2024	Candidates to serve as potential Instructional Materials Review Panel members are solicited according to SBE regulations.
March 12	The SBE receives for approval the recommendations for the appointments to the Review Panels.
March 15	State Superintendent issues the 2024 Call for Bids as authorized with instructions and information for publishers.
April 12	Deadline for publishers to submit the 2024 Intent to Bid.
April 29	12:00 noon bid deadline for Bid Portal submissions and emailing forms.
May 31	Publishers receive Review Panel information for providing samples (print and digital), correlations, briefs, and the schedule of July presentations.
July 26	The SCDE and all Review Panel members must receive electronically the briefs, correlations, and official <u>digital</u> samples including manuscripts.
July 29-August 2	Review Panel orientation meetings with publisher presentations.
August 16	The SCDE and all Panel members must receive <u>print</u> copies of samples.
October 7-11	Panel deliberation meetings to make final adoption recommendations on the instructional materials bid by publishers.
November 1	SC content sample in Thin Common Cartridge must be submitted in preparation for the January 2025 SBE meeting to approve the adoption recommendations.
November 15-December 10	Safari Montage provides publishers with feedback on submitted samples.
November 18-January 3	Public review of recommended instructional materials held virtually and at display sites across the state.
January 7, 2025	The SBE receives the Panel adoption recommendations for approval with a report of the Public Review comments.
February 2025	SCDE and publishers conduct the Instructional Materials Caravan to provide districts and schools with information on the newly adopted instructional materials.
2025–26 School Year	Newly adopted instructional materials are slated for funding for the 2025–26 school year, should the General Assembly provide adequate funding.
