At the November 14, 2017 SBE meeting, the board allocated the remaining funds (\$10,598,597) to ensure \$1 million is allocated to each district/project (\$2,769,738) and evenly distribute the remaining funds (\$7,828,859) to all 48 districts to support renovation projects consistent with the 2017 District Facilities Assessments.

As a result, each district is allocated **\$1,163,101**.
