RE: 2024-25 Multi-Tiered System of Supports (MTSS) Required Reporting

As part of South Carolina's ongoing efforts to support early identification and intervention through a Multi-Tiered System of Supports (MTSS), all districts and charter schools are required by Act 213 to submit annual data on MTSS implementation and literacy universal screening procedures.

The deadline for submitting the 2024-25 MTSS reporting is June 27, 2025.

The reporting requirement consists of two components:

1. A Formstack [survey](#) for district-level data; and
2. A single PowerSchool field for student-level data.

Before completing the survey, please review this year's [MTSS Data Reporting Guide](#), which comprehensively overviews the required data. The Formstack survey includes district-level questions about the universal screening tool(s) used and overall results, district MTSS process, and professional development (PD) information.

The Universal Screening PowerSchool field may be found on the SC Student Information Page and should be completed for all kindergarten and first-grade students. More information on how to complete the PowerSchool field may be found in the MTSS Reporting Guide linked above, as well as the [PowerSchool data entry manual](#).

Districts are encouraged—but not required—to develop procedures for screening students at risk for numeracy and behavioral challenges.
