RE: 2024 Summer Reading Camp Community Partnership Grant Opportunity

The South Carolina Department of Education (SCDE) announces the Request for Proposals (RFP) for the 2024 Summer Reading Camp (SRC) Community Partnership Grant (CPG) under Proviso 1.56 of the General Appropriations Act is now available online. Approximately \$700,000 in funding will be distributed on a competitive basis. The deadline to apply is **5:00 p.m., February 7, 2024**. Applications must be [submitted online](#) and will not be accepted after this deadline.

The purpose of the SRC CPG is to provide grants to provide additional resources to support the SC Read to Succeed Act of 2014 by creating effective partnerships between community organizations and school districts to provide students who are significantly below grade-level reading proficiency with the opportunity to receive quality, intensive instructional services and support.
