RE: 2024 United States Senate Youth Program

The Hearst Foundation's 62nd Annual United States Senate Youth Program (USSYP) Washington Week event will take place March 2-9, 2024, with current plans for a timely national selection process and an in-person program in Washington, D.C.

Two students from each state will be selected to attend and each student will receive a \$10,000 college scholarship. Students must be currently serving in an elected or appointed position representing their school or constituency for the entire 2023-24 school year, must be U.S. citizens or legal permanent residents at the time of application to the U.S. Senate Youth Program, and must be able to attend the entire 2024 in person or online Washington Week event set for March 2-9, 2024. Each high school principal or their designated USSYP scholarship coordinator may submit only one (1) student from their high school through the online application process. Access to the online [Nominator Form](#) will only be available until September 22, 2024.
