RE: Arts Curricular Innovation Grants—2025-26 Distinguished Arts Program Grant Opportunity

The South Carolina Department of Education (SCDE) announces that the 2025–26 Request for Proposals for the Arts Curricular Innovation Grants (ACIG)—**Distinguished Arts Program** grant is now available online. Approximately \$700,000 in funding will be distributed on a competitive basis and the deadline to apply is **April 28, 2025**.

For this funding round, the SCDE will fund one-year projects to schools and districts proposing arts initiatives that significantly improve student achievement in the arts and include all arts forms—dance, music, theatre, and visual arts—over a three-year period of their strategic arts plan.

The SCDE will offer a technical assistance webinar for interested grant applicants on **March 11, 2025, from 3:30 p.m.–5:00 p.m.**, via [Adobe Connect](#). Participants may log in up to 30 minutes in advance of the session to test their equipment and access handouts.
