**RE:** Credit Recovery for Deactivated Math Courses

Course codes for three high school math courses (4113 Algebra 3, 4116 Foundations in Algebra, and 4141 Probability and Statistics) will be deactivated at the end of the 2024-25 school year as of June 30. However, the South Carolina Department of Education (SCDE) is allowing districts to offer credit recovery for these three deactivated math courses during the fall semester of the 2025-26 academic year. The Item Card for each of the three deactivated courses in the Course Code Database will be red, but each card has a comment in the Notes section stating that credit recovery can be offered during the first semester of the 2025-26 school year. Credit recovery for these three deactivated courses will not be available after the fall semester of 2025-26. Districts are encouraged to plan appropriately to accommodate all credit recovery needs.

We are asking for your assistance in identifying districts and schools that will be providing credit recovery for these deactivated courses during the fall semester of the upcoming school year. Please complete the [Credit Recovery for Deactivated Math Courses form](#) by Friday, August 22. This information will help the SCDE manually clear any Level Data errors or validation flags that may occur.
