RE: Education and Economic Development Act Accountability Deadlines

For accountability purposes related to the Education and Economic Development Act (EEDA), the Office of Career and Technical Education and Student Transition Services collects the Career Specialist Accountability Report (CSAR) twice each year—in January and June—to ensure school counseling personnel are coordinating or facilitating various career awareness, exploration, and preparation opportunities for students throughout the academic year. Additionally, data is collected from the individual graduation plans that must be developed or annually updated for all students in grades 8–12.

The Career Specialist Accountability Report (CSAR) data represents all career awareness activities for students in grades 6–12. District EEDA Accountability Coordinators are responsible for collecting CSAR data from their schools, consolidating the data, and submitting the district CSAR to the SCDE. The SCDE will offer virtual Technical Assistance on August 29th at 9:00 to assist districts with data collection.

Please ensure your district has designated and/or updated the Education and Economic Development Act (EEDA) Accountability Coordinator in the District & Entity Information Management (DEIM) system.
