RE: English Language Development (ELD) Standards Framework Implementation

The *WIDA English Language Development (ELD) Standards Framework, 2020 Edition: Kindergarten-Grade 12* was publicly released on December 18, 2020, and formally adopted by the South Carolina Board of Education in May 2021. During the 2021-22 school year, professional learning opportunities and stakeholder committee work has served as a bridge to full roll-out and implementation during the 2022-23 school year. This updated, comprehensive edition fosters the assets, contributions, and potential of multilingual learners (MLs). With this edition, WIDA continues to advance the field of language development in support of disciplinary learning. It is important to note that any changes to the English Language Proficiency (ELP) assessment, ACCESS for ELLs, reflecting the revised framework will not occur immediately. According to communications to states in May 2021, WIDA estimates that new ACCESS for ELLs test items based on the 2020 Edition would be operationalized no sooner than 2024-25. Additional information regarding the implementation timeline for revised assessments will be provided as it becomes available from WIDA.

The Office of Federal and State Accountability, in collaboration with the Office of Assessment and Standards, has provided professional development to the field throughout the 2021-22 school year in preparation for full implementation.
