RE: NLGA Lt. Governor's STEM Scholarship Program

South Carolina Lieutenant Governor Pamela Evette asked the Department to make each of you aware of an opportunity available to your schools. The National Lieutenant Governors Association (NLGA) annually awards a scholarship to 12 different schools for STEM-related projects in the classroom. The first scholarships were awarded in 2022. Teachers or project advisors in state-accredited public, private, or tribal pre-K-12 grade schools may apply for a scholarship to further STEM education through a project, equipment, program, or curriculum.

Eight schools across the country will be awarded \$1,000 each and four schools will be awarded \$500 each. Funding is awarded to the school listed on the application. If selected, NLGA will notify the winning submitter and school and provide the check to the school.

The application window is open now and will close on March 15. Don't delay your application!
