The South Carolina Department of Education (SCDE) announces that the 2020–21 Request for Proposals for the 21st Century Community Learning Centers (CCLC) grant program is now available online. Approximately \$7 million in funding will be distributed on a competitive basis and the deadline to apply is **April 20, 2020**.

The SCDE will fund public school districts, community-based organizations, Indian tribes or tribal organizations, and other public or private entities. Applicants must propose to establish or expand activities in community learning centers that provide opportunities for academic enrichment and tutorial services; offer students a broad array of additional services, programs, and activities; and offer families of students served opportunities for literacy and related educational development.

The SCDE will offer an onsite technical assistance workshop for interested grant applicants on **March 6, 2020, at 10:00 a.m.** at the SC State Farmer's Market, 3483 Charleston Highway, West Columbia, SC 29172.
