We are pleased to announce that the United States Department of Education has approved additional waivers for the South Carolina Department of Education, authorized under the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act (CARES Act), Pub. L. No. 116-136 (March 27, 2020), which provides substantial relief to children and educators who have been profoundly affected by the COVID-19.

This additional flexibility impacts K–12 education funding under the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act. Please see the memo linked below for further information.
