



# Emergency Assistance to Nonpublic Schools (EANS)

## PROGRAM NOTICE

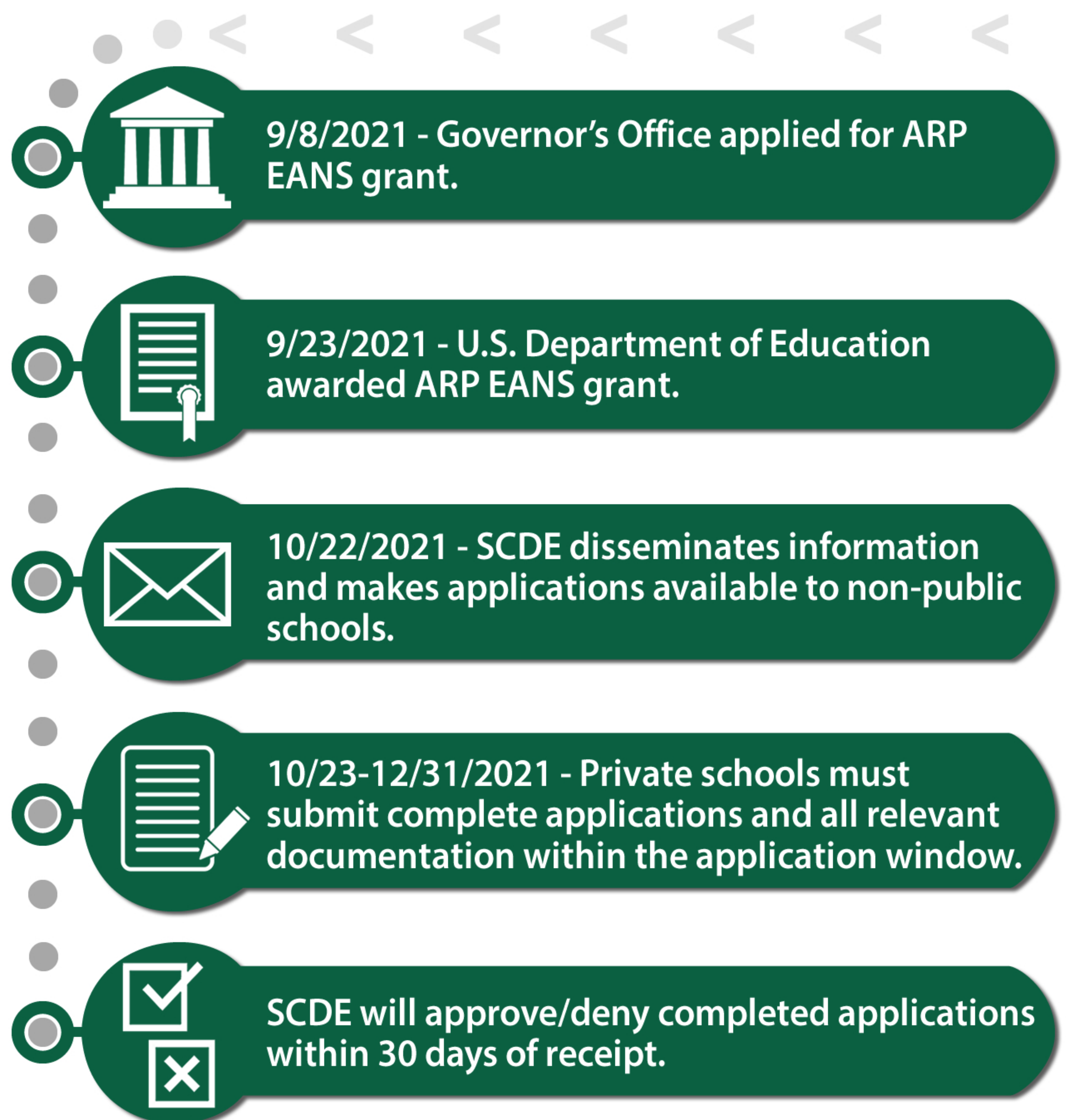
Section 2002 of the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 (ARP Act) requires the United States Department of Education to reserve \$2,750,000,000 for making a second round of allocations to Governors under the Emergency Assistance to Non-Public Schools (EANS) program, originally authorized under section 312(d) of the Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act, 2021 (CRRSA Act).

South Carolina has been awarded \$40,560,267, of which, \$40,357,466 will be available to eligible nonprofit, nonpublic schools in South Carolina.

### Private School Eligibility

- Must be established as a non-profit entity.
- Must have been in existence prior to March 13, 2020.
- Must be licensed, accredited, or otherwise approved to operate in accordance with State law.
- Did not and will not apply for and receive a loan under the Small Business Administration's Paycheck Protection Program (PPP) (15 U.S.C. 636(a)(37)) that is made on or after December 27, 2020.
- Must have enrolled at least 40% of students from low-income families during the 2020-2021 school year.
- Must be most impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic.
