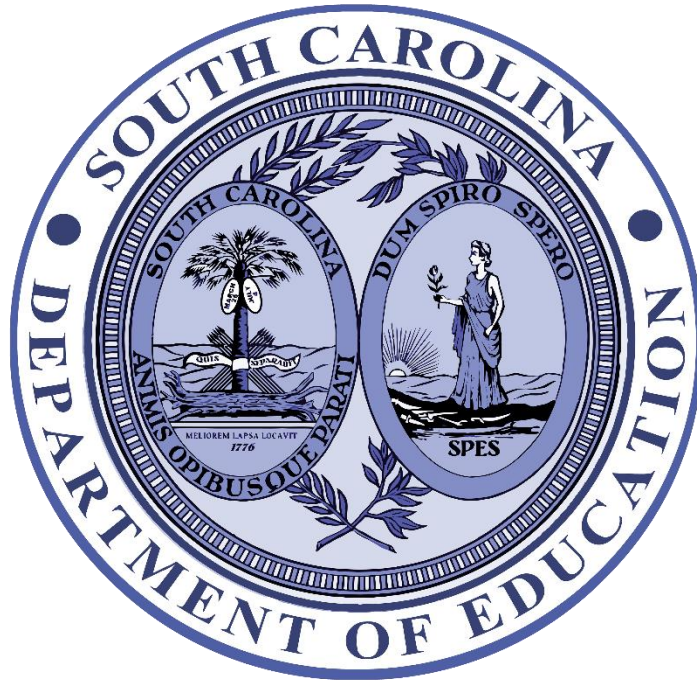

Uniform Guidance

According to the Uniform Guidance [2 C.F.R. 200.332\(d\)](#), A grantee shall monitor subrecipients and any other entities, including external providers, receiving Federal funds from programs to ensure that all applicable fiscal and programmatic performance goals are achieved and that subawards are used for authorized purposes and in compliance with Federal statutes, regulations, and the terms and conditions of Federal awards.



The Program Monitoring Process

	Process	Participants	Projected Dates
Phase One	Self-Assessment	All South Carolina LEAs	August 3, 2023- September 7, 2023
Phase Two	Desk Audit	Selected South Carolina LEAs	October 20, 2023- November 17, 2023
Phase Three	Field Monitoring	Selected South Carolina LEAs	February 12, 2024- April 12, 2024
Phase Four	Plan of Corrective Action	Selected South Carolina LEAs	May 3, 2024-May 17, 2024

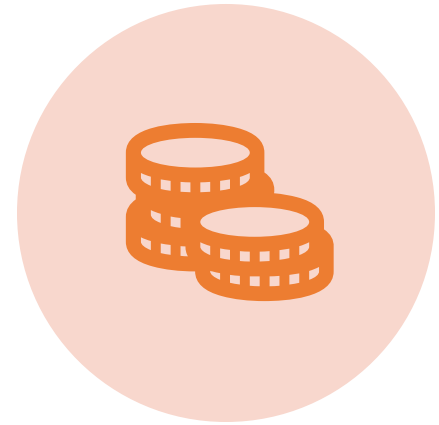
